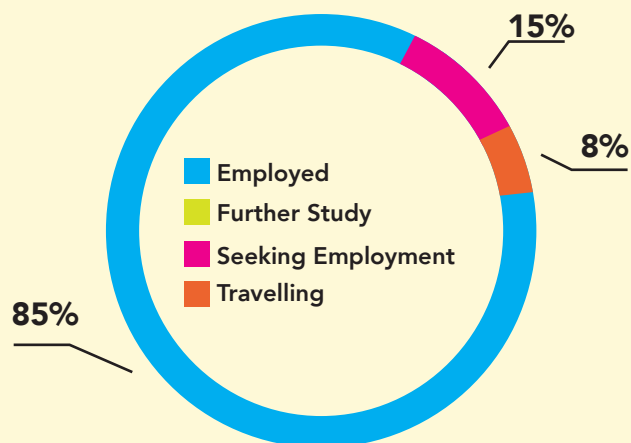
Overview:

- 37 students graduated from the BSc (Hons) in Computing programme in November 2022.
 - (19%) graduated with a data analytics specialism
 - (59%) with software development specialism
 - (22%) with cyber security specialism.
- 85% of respondents are employed and 93% of those in employment are employed in graduate employment.
- Salary insights: 21% were on salaries between €30,000 - €34,999, 8% reported earning a salary of between €35,000 - €39,999. 42% were earning between €40,000 - €44,999. 4% reported earnings of between €45,000 - €49,999. 13% were on salaries between €50,000 - €59,999.
