## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

- 1. All applicants are automatically assessed for a range of scholarships. This form should only be used where a student wishes to apply for one of the scholarships not assessed as part of the standard application process.
- 2. To be eligible for consideration of an international scholarship, applicants must:
  - a. have been offered a place on an eligible full-time course
  - b. be classed as overseas students for tuition fee purposes
  - c. have confirmed their place as required
- 3. Students who are sponsored by their employers, government or a funding body (full / part) are not eligible to apply for this scholarship award.
- 4. Applicants are only able to apply for an international scholarship once.
- 5. Scholarship application deadline must be strictly adhered to.
- 6. Applications received after the final deadline will not be considered.
- 7. A scholarship offer is made subject to adherence to all subsequent deadlines for deposit and full fee payments.
- 8. The scholarship will be available in the form of a tuition fee reduction. If you are awarded a scholarship, your fee will be adjusted before you enrol on year one.
- 9. Candidates may apply for a number of scholarships and if they are successful in attaining more than one scholarship, candidates will be awarded the scholarship of highest value. Scholarships cannot be added together or combined.
- 10. Candidates cannot transfer or use one scholarship between or against another programme. Scholarships are also not allowed to be deferred to a future academic year, it is only applicable and awarded to the student for the year they are offered a place at NCI. If a student, subsequently, decides to defer their offer they will lose their scholarship and will be required to apply for any future scholarship award.
- 11. Scholarships are automatically renewed each year of a programme, on condition that the student maintains 65% and meets the programme progression and credit requirements within one academic year. Failure to meet this requirement will see the scholarship revoked.
- 12. The scholarship is not transferable and will not be awarded if you choose to defer your entry to a different academic year or if you choose to transfer to a different course at the College.
- 13. Applicants will be informed of whether they have (or have not) been awarded a scholarship (with the value of the scholarship award if they have been awarded) within four weeks of the application deadline dates.
- 14. The scholarship will only be awarded once an applicant accepts and meets the conditions of their offer, accepts their scholarship offer, pays all or part of their fees and is eligible to enrol on the course.
- 15. Scholarships are competitive and limited in availability. Selection is based on the information you provide on your initial application and on this scholarship application form. It is, therefore, of great importance that you give your personal statement careful thought and preparation and you refer to the criteria provided.
- 16. The college's decision in all matters relating to the scholarship is final.
- 17. The college reserves the right to revoke the scholarship if you leave the college before completing the programme.
- 18. If your scholarship application is successful, you may be asked to appear in online and / or printed college marketing materials. This may involve providing a student profile and a photograph which may be used to promote the college's scholarship schemes and courses. By accepting a scholarship offer, you are also deemed to have accepted the marketing requirements as stated above.
